STATE OF THE UNION MUST FOCUS ON JOBS, JOBS, JOBS *Statement from Assemblyman Marcus J. Molinaro (R,I,C-Red Hook)*

"Whether at the local, state, and federal level, the primary concern among citizens is our perilous economy. As the president lays out his agenda for the upcoming year tomorrow night during his State of the Union address, improving our economy, assisting in job growth, and alleviating the high costs of living must be the priority. The dialogue in Albany and Washington must shift so that we can find common ground to help the millions of New Yorkers struggling in this recession."
