BILLS INTRODUCED:

A09657

Relates to the definition of the term "prior assessment" for the purposes of transition assessments.

A09662

Prohibits a statewide elected official, state officer or employee, member of the legislature or legislative employee to use state aircraft for political purposes.

A09673

Establishes a person is guilty of aggravated harassment in the second degree when, with the intent to harass, annoy, threaten or alarm another person he or she transmits or delivers a written communication, which includes a recording, in a manner likely to cause annoyance or alarm.
