BILLS INTRODUCED:

A10576

Establishes silver alert system to track missing elder persons suffering from dementia, Alzheimer`s disease, or other cognitive impairment; functions through division of criminal justice services.

A10672

Grants service credit to active firefighters who serve as paid employees within a political subdivision for activities performed during regular work periods.

A10681

Provides for absentee voting for municipalities, school and fire districts on local elections.

A10682

Provides for the disclosure of the identity of the sponsors of political communications, including those printed or broadcasted which advocate the

election or defeat of a particular candidate, and whether or not such communication is endorsed by the candidate; exempts individual expenditures.

A10678

Establishes a gift for the autism awareness and research fund on the personal income tax form.
