**BILLS INTRODUCED:**

A10558

Enacts "Trenton`s law"; requires the furnishing of an original birth certificate at the time of enrollment of a child into a child day care center; provides that if one is not supplied, the director or operator shall contact the statewide central register for missing and exploited children.

A10566

Establishes that adults in control of private property are responsible for alcoholic beverages provided to minors at social events held on the property.
