BILLS INTRODUCED:

A10681

Provides for absentee voting for municipalities, school and fire districts on local elections.

A10682

Provides for the disclosure of the identity of the sponsors of political communications, including those printed or broadcasted which advocate the election or defeat of a particular candidate, and whether or not such communication is endorsed by the candidate.

A11132

Creates the crime of obstructing telephonic or electronic communication for immediate assistance.

A11199

Provides that the assessment of any parcel with a contaminated private water

well shall provide for the consideration of the extent to which such contamination affects the potability of the water in the well, the marketability of the parcel and any remedial actions that have been taken.

A11228

Eliminates state sales and compensating use taxes on motor fuels and diesel motor fuels and authorizes localities to eliminate such taxes at the local level.
