**BILLS INTRODUCED:**

A08803 Designates a portion of state route 9-H in the county of Columbia as the "Columbia County veterans` Memorial Highway". A08831 Authorizes the Town of Northeast to establish community preservation fund. A08805 Establishes the regents nursing professional's loan forgiveness program for applicants who agree to engage in employment as a nurse in hospitals, nursing homes and hospice centers.
