ACTIVITIES:

Participated in several meetings of the Human Services Budget Conference Committee. Attended meeting of the General Government & Public Protection Budget Conference Committee. BILLS INTRODUCED:

A10140

Requires NYSERDA to establish a program of public awareness of the use and benefits of biofuel.

A10141

Establishes a biofuel/biodiesel permit process task force; administered by NYSERDA.

A10142

Prohibits certain adverse actions by public employers to be taken against public employees and provides remedies for violations and increases the scope of protected employee activity.

A10225

Establishes the volunteer firefighters and emergency medical service volunteer tuition assistance grant program.

A10238

Provides grants and low interest loans to dairy farms who make energy efficient improvements.

A10241

Relates to the disqualification of tax delinquent bidders with some exceptions; provides that no agency shall be permitted to enter into a contract with a bidder or subcontractor who has an unsatisfied warrant filed against him or her pursuant to provisions of the tax law.

A10329

Provides for the termination of the state mortgage recording tax.

A10427

Relates to identifying the incidence and needs of those affected by autism spectrum disorder in this state and requiring training of education personnel.
