BILLS INTRODUCED:

A07171 Authorizes the Hudson VFW Post 1314 to file an application for a real property tax exemption for the tax year 2005. A07267 Relates to extending the authorization for imposition of additional sales and compensating use tax in Columbia County until 2009. A06799 Allows volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers to be eligible for such credit if they received such real property tax exemption in the 2007 taxable year. A06831 Relates to creating a day care assistance program for members of the organized militia serving federal active duty outside the United States. A06921 Establishes the "address confidentiality program" for victims of domestic violence. A07189 To amend the Labor Law, in order to exempt contractors building new one-family residential construction from the requirements of Sections 240 and 241 (Scaffold Act). A07277 Promotes the most-integrated services available for individuals, especially those with disabilities.
