ACTIVITIES:

Attended Columbia County Chamber of Commerce Executive Committee Meeting and participated in “celebrity” cooking presentation in Hudson. Participated in Dr. Seuss’ Birthday and read to students at Wingdale Elementary School in Dover. BILLS INTRODUCED:

A05872 Repeals provision prohibiting volunteer firefighters from receiving both the local option real property tax exemption and the personal income tax credit at the same time. A02215 Authorizes counties and towns to restrict speed limits to less than 55 MPH on county roads and town highways. A05206 Provides for direct reimbursement to forensic pediatricians for forensic physical abuse assessments by the crime victims board. A05361 Provides for a deduction against personal gross income in an amount equal to fees, costs and expenses paid or incurred including legal fees and agency costs in connection with the adoption of a child. A05378 Creates a small business electric energy tax credit. A05430 Relates to information disseminated on level three sex offenders. A05480 Requires that any person convicted of an alcohol related offense be required to participate in the ignition interlock device program. A05486 Requires course work and training in tick-borne diseases by every physician, nurse, lab technologist and pharmacist. A05707 Requires the search for burglary conviction records for volunteer firefighter applicants. A06016 Creates crime of cyberstalking in the first degree.
