**BILLS INTRODUCED:**

A10053

Relates to state aid for certain cities adversely affected by a concentration of tax exempt property.

A10061

Creates an exception to the competitive bidding process for certain purchases and contracts.

A10069

Creates a course of instruction to train mental health providers in veteran specific mental health issues.

A10070

Requires instruction in organ, eye and tissue donation in senior high schools

by health teachers.

A10075

Makes the canal corporation an independent public authority; takes the canal corporation out of the jurisdiction and authority of the New York state thruway authority.

A10080

Relates to enacting the toy and product recall protection and enforcement act.

A09303

Prohibits a pharmacist from substituting any anti-epileptic drug for the prescribed anti-epileptic drug without notification of and the informed consent of the prescriber and patient or such patient's parent, guardian or spouse.
