**ACTIVITIES:**

Staff held office hours at East Fishkill Town Hall. Met with editorial boards of the Hudson Register Star and Independent newspapers with Senator Saland regarding Governor's decision to close the Hudson Correctional Facility. **BILLS INTRODUCED:**

A10151 Relates to confidentiality of information contained in pistol license applications.

A10156 Provides that the income level for the requirement to file a personal income tax return shall be the dollar amount of the New York standard deduction.

A10189 Allows the detention of a respondent of a "sex offender requiring civil management petition" pending trial.

A10225 Establishes the volunteer firefighters and emergency medical service volunteer tuition assistance grant program.

A10238 Provides grants and low interest loans to dairy farms who make energy efficient improvements.

A10241 Relates to the disqualification of tax delinquent bidders with some exceptions; provides that no agency shall be permitted to enter into a contract with a bidder or subcontractor who has an unsatisfied warrant filed against him or her pursuant to provisions of the tax law.

A10301 Relates to registration in the New York state donate life registry for organ and tissue donations on application forms for voter enrollment.

A10329 Provides for the termination of the state mortgage recording tax.
