BILLS INTRODUCED:

A06655 Relates to an exemption for real property owned by an incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department; A06799 Relates to the volunteer firefighters` and ambulance workers` property tax credit; A06831 Relates to creating a day care assistance program for members of the organized militia serving federal active duty outside the United States; A06921 Establishes the "address confidentiality program" for victims of domestic violence; A07277 Promotes the most-integrated services available for individuals, especially those with disabilities; A07344 Prohibits an employer from terminating an employee who is also a volunteer firefighter or an enrolled member of a volunteer ambulance service; A07405 Creates the statewide commission on chronic disease tracking; A07444 Provides for the forfeiture of unspent campaign funds after conviction and resignation of the elected official; A07446 Restricts the use of campaign contributions from use for legal fees associated

with defense of civil or criminal cases; A07516 Directs the commissioner of parks, recreation and historic preservation to establish a program of free parking for senior citizens; A07667 Exempts hybrid vehicles from sales and compensating use tax; A07680 Increases the tax credit allowed volunteer firefighters or ambulance workers; A08029 Relates to aid for the purchase of school library materials.
