BILLS INTRODUCED:

A625-A: Co-sponsor
Relates to offering parental controls for internet services

A661-A: Co-sponsor
Provides that the income level for the requirement to file a personal income tax return shall be set by regulation

A1527-C: Co-sponsor
Creates the crime of luring or enticing a child on the internet

A2733-A: Co-sponsor
Establishes the volunteer firefighting and volunteer emergency services recruitment and retention fund and authorizes gifts to such fund through a state

A7874:
Relates to providing a performance of duty disability retirement benefit for members of the armed forces injured in combat

A7887: Co-sponsor
Provides for direct reimbursement to forensic pediatricians for forensic physical abuse assessments by the crime victims board
