BILLS INTRODUCED:

A1580-B

Relates to enacting the agreement among the states to elect the president by national popular vote.

A6662: Co-sponsor

Establishes a registry to help locate individuals with autism, Alzheimer's and dementia in the event they go missing.

A6736: Co-sponsor

Provides that students who have an IEP shall not be required to take more than one regents examination in any given day.

A6749

Grants 100% exemption on school tax where all owners of real property are 65 years or older.

A6759

Provides for lowering co-payments for covered drugs for certain participants in the elderly pharmaceutical insurance coverage program.

A6791: Co-sponsor

Requires additional investigation when three or more claims of abuse or maltreatment of a child are made relating to the same person.

A6811: Co-sponsor

Authorizes victims to make a rebuttal of the defendant's statement at the sentencing.
